The Georgia Republican Party is truly a grassroots party. In a four-year cycle there are three conventions. In the odd years, conventions are held to elect leadership from the precinct to the state party officials. In the Presidential even years, conventions are held from the precinct to the national level yielding national delegates that will represent us in establishing and maintaining distinct public policy in our platform. Step 3 District Convention

Saturday, April 18, 2009 - 10:00 a.m.

- Elect Convention Chairman
- Elect District Chairman and other District officers to serve for two years
- Elect District members to serve on State Committee

Delegates/alternates elected at Precinct Caucus to Attend County Convention

Delegates/alternates elected at County Convention to attend District and State Conventions

Step 2 County Convention

Saturday, March 14, 2009 - 10:00 a.m.

- Elect Convention Chairman
- Elect County Chairman, other officers, and County Committee members to serve for two years
- Elect Delegates and Alternates to the District and State Conventions
- **Note: Counties with populations under 80,000 will hold their Precinct Meetings at 9:00 a.m. before County Convention.**

Step 1 Precinct Caucus (Mass Meetings)

Saturday, February 7, 2009 - 10:00 a.m.

- Counties with population of **over** 80,000
- Meetings are held in locations designated by the County Party and published by the Party in the newspaper
- Elect Precinct Meeting Chairman and Secretary
- Elect Precinct Officers to serve for two years
- Elect Delegates and Alternates to the County Conventions
